



SUSAK & SRAKANE

Boat Tour



THE ISLAND OF SUSAK Lošinj forms with its islands unique а archipelago in the north Adriatic Sea. After a pleasant boat trip you reach the most unique of all the Adriatic islands, the island of Susak. Susak is unique as well as by its arising and in its appearance. Prehistoric winds piled thick layers of fine yellow sand on a limestone slab and formed this unique island. Two villages are located on the island, the upper and the lower village. The people lived from fishing and wine

production. The traditions of the indigenous people, viticulture and sandy beaches make the island of Susak famous and popular.

OTOK VELE SRAKANE

Vele Srakane is 2.5 km long, with surface area of 1.2 km2. On the hill of Vela straža, 60 m above sea level, there is a prehistoric hill-fort. The old citadel is the remain of a semi-circular wall of a former fortress which was used as a defense against sea raiders. A tombstone from Roman times is embedded in the corner of Skrivanić House.
