THE ISLAND ILOVIK

The two neighboring islands, Ilovik and Saint Peter, are the extension of the southern part of Lošinj separated from Lošinj by the strait called "Door of Ilovik". The island Ilovik has a surface of 5.8 km² and 15.4 km of coastline. A canal approximately 2.5 km long and 300 m wide divides the two islands Ilovik and S. Peter. Therefore, these waters offer protection to yachts and smaller boats. On the island of Ilovik only one

village of the same name is located. The island has a Mediterranean vegetation, with different types of flowers, oleanders, palms and Eucalyptus trees. Some call the island "The flower Island".

THE ISKAND VELE ORJULE

Vele Orjule is located 1.5 km east of the island of Lošinj near the islet of Trasorka. Southeast, in the immediate vicinity is the islet of Male Orjule. The northernmost point of Vele Orjule is Cape Glavičina. In the bay Darvarić, in the north of the island, are the ruins of some buildings. The highest peak of the island is: Pristavnica, 30m.
